The RWHCP is a voluntary program for industry developers that reduces liability and provides the opportunity for federal permits in relation to the conservation of the Lesser Prairie Chicken.

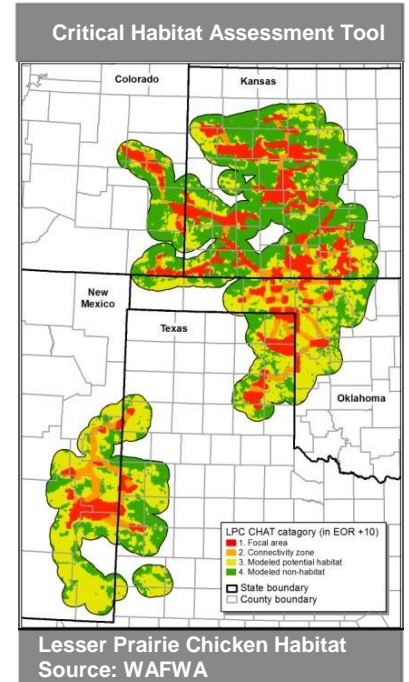
